



# Premium Inkjet Transfer Paper for White and Light Colored Fabrics

Reverse side of this paper has a yellow line

## ITEMS YOU WILL NEED

- White or light color Cotton, Cotton/Polyester Blend, or stretchable fabrics like Lycra™
- Heat Press or Iron.  
**Do not use steam**
- Pillowcase
- Hard smooth surface (example: Formica)  
**Do not use an ironing board**

## STEP ONE – PRINTING YOUR IMAGE

- 1) Bring paper to room temperature before printing.
- 2) Load the sheet into your printer so that it will print on the non-glossy (unlined) side.
- 3) Print image/design on paper.  
**Be sure to mirror or flip image prior to printing.**

Recommended print settings:

<u>HP</u>	–	Media: Iron on T-Shirt Transfer Print Mode: Normal or Best
<u>Epson</u>	–	Media: Plain Paper Print Mode: Photo
<u>Canon</u>	–	Media: Photo Paper Plus Glossy Print Mode: High
<u>Lexmark</u>	–	Media: Plain Paper Print Mode: Best
<u>Brother</u>	--	Media: Inkjet Paper Print Mode: Photo

**Do not use printers that have heating elements in them, such as the Hewlett-Packard 1200C.**

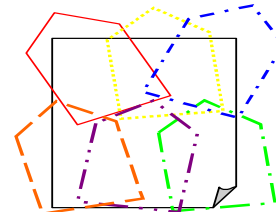
## STEP TWO – TRANSFERRING YOUR IMAGE

### HEAT PRESS

- 1) Preheat press to **385° - 400° F.**
- 2) Set press at **high pressure (60 psi)** for best results.
- 3) Press garment for 3-5 seconds to release moisture and remove wrinkles.
- 4) Place printed image face down on the garment (the lined side will be facing up).
- 5) Press for **30 seconds.**

## HAND IRON

- 1) Preheat your iron to the “Linen” setting. Lay a pillowcase on the ironing surface.
- 2) Place your garment on the pillowcase and pre-iron your garment to release moisture and remove wrinkles. Place your printed image face down on the garment (the lined side will be the ironing surface).
- 3) Using **FIRM STEADY PRESSURE**, holding iron with both hands and applying your body weight, iron on each area of the sheet for **20** seconds making sure to lift the iron completely when moving to a new position. Continue this process until you have completely ironed the entire sheet. Be sure also to cover all corners and edges.

## STEP THREE – TWO WAYS TO PEEL

### COLD PEEL

- 1) **Wait at least two minutes** for the transfer to cool
- 2) Remove paper using a smooth, even motion.

### HOT PEEL

- 1) **Wait 5 seconds.**
- 2) Remove paper while still **Hot/Warm** using a smooth, even motion.

**Test results demonstrate better color retention during washing with HOT PEEL method.**

Store unused sheets in a re-sealable poly bag. Store flat in a cool, dry area.

For best results, transfer shortly after printing as stored printed sheets can fade.

## WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

- Turn the garment inside out.
- Wash in **COLD** water.
- Use a mild detergent for best results.
- **Do not use bleach or bleach alternative detergents.**
- Remove the garment promptly from the washer.  
**The color may bleed if left in the washer.**
- Dry on **LOW** temperature.
